Greenville teachers have received an “A” rating from Niche, earned because 70% of their teaching staff have Masters Degrees or higher. Greenville High School has received the Gold Award from the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania and was nominated as a Blue Ribbon School by the United States Department of Education for academic achievement. Only 50 schools a year out of thousands of American High Schools receive this recognition in any given year. Their top SAT scores include 1546, 1520, and 1486.

Greenville High School has partnered with two universities: the University of Pittsburgh and Seton Hill University. The University of Pittsburgh is ranked #33 in the USA by EduRank and #62 by US News and World Report. Greenville High School offers 33 university credits on-site. Students can in theory complete 1 year of university study. Other well-respected top 100 U.S. universities that Greenville graduates have attended include Ivy League schools Harvard University and the University of Pennsylvania, Others include Bucknell University, Cornell University, Carnegie Mellon University, Notre Dame University, Case Western University, United States Naval Academy, as well as Pennsylvania State University and Ohio State University.



Greenville High School serves as the perfect pathway program for international students. Through its association with American Education Pathway, English language support and tutoring are available to international students. TOEFL training and SAT Prep are also available. University counseling as well as application assistance is also provided at no extra charge.



Greenville High School offers over 30 sports and clubs. Some of the sports include Football, Basketball, Wrestling, Track & Field, and Tennis. Some of the clubs include Media, Science, Thespians, and Forensics. The Greenville Steel Drum Band has been nationally ranked and has performed all over the USA and Canada. Participating in sports or clubs is highly suggested. Participation helps integrate students into the community, meet American friends as well as students from other countries, and furthers English language acquisition.
